The Statewide Tobacco Education Program (STEP), developed by the Connecticut Prevention Network, is an innovative and activity-based curriculum for youth ages 5-14.

The (5) one hour sessions were designed to be a perfect fit in a variety of settings including summer camps, positive youth development programs, boys and girls clubs and traditional classroom locations.

The curriculum is composed of 5 modules that promote tobacco prevention for youth in a unique format. The modules included are:

- Introduction
- Environment and the Media
 - Healthy vs. Unhealthy
 - Cost and Choices
- Dealing with Peer Pressure
